- The Parish straddles the second largest rail hub in NSW. This has changed the face of the suburb from predominantly low-rise residential and suburban blocks, to an expanding corridor of high and medium density apartment blocks close to the station.

The parish is wishing to maintain its traditional style of worship, that appeals to current members and the culturally tradition oriented demographic, **and** to reach out to people who may find a different style more helpful.

There are three primary schools in the parish, with West Epping reputed to be one of the largest primary schools in NSW. Two of the schools are located within 200m of our two church buildings.
